For the last 50 years, the conference of the Italian Association of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics has been an important meeting place for scientists working in the field of general, fluid, solid and structural mechanics, as well as mechanics for machines and mechanical systems. The aim of the meeting is to promote an exchange of ideas and expertise among the participants, to stimulate interest in novel research topics, and to share the most recent scientific results in the field. The conference's topics are related to all aspects of scientific research in mechanics, including theoretical, computational and experimental techniques and technological applications. The meeting also covers new multidisciplinary approaches. The conference will host invited plenary lectures, minisymposia on specific and emerging themes, as well as general sessions on the more traditional topics in mechanics. The XXIV AIMETA Conference is organized with the support of the Department of Structural and Geotechnical Engineering of Sapienza University of Rome and will be held at the Faculty of Civil and Industrial Engineering from 15 September to 19 September 2019.

Sapienza's network of specialised labs opens its doors to students who wish to conduct a study or research project. SAPeri&Co is a Sapienza research and services facility that was conceived to promote excellence in applied research and provide dedicated services for companies and agencies. SAPeri&Co is conceived as a hub that interconnects a number of university labs and competences with a central node on campus at the Tumminelli Building.

Starting today, the SAPeri&Co Labs are also open to students. Indeed, university students enrolled in any degree programme, including PhD students, can now participate in a call to be hosted by SAPeri&Co for 2-12 months to develop a project in a multidisciplinary and collaborative environment.

The call is open for the entire year and SAPeri&Co can host 25 students at a time.

The Call Call Saperi X Researcher is open to all PhD students of the Sapienza University of Rome. Winners of the call will be hosted in the SAPeri&Co Hub from 2 to 4 months - depending on the project's requirements - to develop their idea in a multidisciplinary and collaborative environment.

#### ✓ Saperi X Senior

The Call Saperi X Senior is open to all students enrolled in a Master Degree Master Degree Program (both 2 or 5 years program) of the Sapienza University of Rome. The call gives students the opportunity to be hosted in the SAPeri&Co Hub for a period of time varying between 2 and 6 months (depending on the complexity of the project), with the purpose of developing an idea in a multidisciplinary and collaborative environment.
